

JAIME JURADO

Born in Lucena, Córdoba in 1976, Jaime Jurado was graduated in the Art College "Escuela de Artes Aplicadas y Oficios Mateo Inurria" of Córdoba.

Several of Jurado's artworks were created using a wide variety of mixed techniques, including the introduction of collage to develop big format pieces, and in a very expressive and stunning way.

In his paintings Jurado combines his vision of reality the way it is, while also adding wise subjective brush-strokes and newspaper clippings, where sometimes a few words can be read as if they were part of his landscapes wish to whisper them as expressions from far away.

Each of Jaime Jurado's artworks has an enormous richness in terms of aesthetic quality. A perspective that takes the viewer from an objective reality that is somehow filtered to a point of unique serenity which his art transmits.
